## **At the Table: Finding Your Place in God's Family**

### ***A 4-week new members class at Lake Lynn***

Theme Verse: “So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God.” – Ephesians 2:19

#### *Week 1 – Welcome Home*

Big Idea: Church is not a building you attend but a family you belong to.

- The story of Lake Lynn and the “Come Home” vision.
- Pastor’s testimony and call to this church.
- Why membership matters: belonging, covenant, identity.
- I Am a Church Member principle: Membership is about giving, not getting.
- Application: Share your story—how did God bring you here?

## ***Week 2 – What We Believe***

Big Idea: A healthy family has shared beliefs that shape how it lives.

- Overview of the Baptist Faith & Message 2000.
  - The gospel, salvation, baptism, and the Lord's Supper.
  - The authority of Scripture.
  - I Am a Church Member principle: Unity matters more than personal preferences.
  - Application: Where do you need to pursue unity?

## ***Week 3 – How We Live Together***

Big Idea: Being at home in God's family means living as disciples on mission.

- The DNA of a disciple (Kingdom, Disciple, Society, Church).
- Practices of disciples: prayer, worship, giving, serving, witness.
- Life together at Lake Lynn: Sunday worship, groups, serving, mission.
- I Am a Church Member principle: I will pray for my church leaders and serve faithfully.
- Application: Choose one new spiritual habit to commit to this month.

## Week 4 – Your Place at the Table

Big Idea: Every member has a role to play in the family of God.

- Discovering gifts and serving opportunities at Lake Lynn.
- Living as everyday missionaries in Fayetteville.
- Membership covenant: worship, grow, serve, give, go.
- I Am a Church Member principle: I will see membership as a gift.
- Application: Sign covenant, share next steps, and celebrate together.
